Reason for the change?

A new Government Legislation has been implemented in the Northern Territory (NT), requiring all liquor sold into the territory complies with a **Minimum Unit Price of \$1.30 per standard drink**. The legislation also applies to **ALL** products sold online that may be despatched from another state or store into the NT.

What has Changed?

Due to the new NT Legislation, the Article form has been updated to include two new mandatory fields (as shown below) for Liquor Suppliers to fill in who supply to Australia (AU).

1. Alcohol Content %
2. No. Of Standard drinks

Woolworths New Article Summary (WNAS) for Local Articles -

What actions are required?

- Suppliers are to ensure the new mandatory fields are completed for all AU Liquor Articles.
- Please ensure the latest version of WNAS v5.3 is used, which is now available on Wowlink under [Product Maintenance Forms](#).

- Non Liquor Suppliers - BSS will continue to accept the old version of the WNAS v5.2 until Sunday 9th September 2018.
